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#### SILVER CERTIFICATION – some issues

#### How is Silver different to PH Standard?

- •higher space heat demand limit (40) requires more efficiency in other areas to reach same PE limit
- allows MEV
- •Gives recognition for projects aiming for PH but that don't reach it for various reasons on site may still be an excellent low energy building
- •Worth AECB members exploring how it might be useful in retrofit projects, but discussion needed as was designed for new build


